

KNOW THE TRUTH!

John 8:32

"And <u>ye shall know the truth</u>, and the truth shall make you free."

The word "<u>know</u>" has been translated "<u>understand</u>" 7 times. Even the carnal Christians at Corinth could understand <u>if</u> they wanted to.

Speaking to the Corinthians in <u>First</u> <u>Corinthians 2:10</u>, we read that God reveals the truth "by His Spirit." Again, in <u>First Corinthians 2:13</u> we read "...the Holy Ghost teacheth...spiritual things..."

The Holy Spirit Only Teaches Those Who Want To Be Taught.

First Corinthians 2:15 plainly says, "He that is spiritual **judgeth** all things." **To judge** is to hold an investigation. **To investigate** is to "carry out a systematic or formal inquiry to discover and examine the facts."

We Have No Excuse For Ignorance.

There are more than <u>250 references</u> in the Bible referring to <u>understanding</u>.
