Recent Internet Reports

- Global conflict has increased in 2023, with more than 15,000 additional attacks, bombings and assaults compared to 2022.
- Oct. 7, 2023 1,200 innocent Israelis were slaughtered by Palestinians in one day.
- <u>Since Oct. 7, 2023</u> 200 violent events involving US forces in the Middle East have occurred, compared to just 12 in the preceding nine months.

United Nations Reports

- Today, <u>crime</u> kills far more people than armed conflicts.
- In <u>2017</u>, almost half a million people across the world were killed in homicides (500,000 people).

- Organized crime kills as many people as all armed conflicts combined.
- From 2000-2017 armed conflict killings totalled a million people.
- <u>From 2000-2017</u> organized crime killings totalled a million people.
- For women and girls, the home is now the most dangerous place.
- In <u>2017</u> <u>58</u> % of female homicides were carried out by "intimate partners" or family members, up from <u>47</u> % in <u>2012</u>.
- Children aged <u>14</u> years or under in <u>2017</u> -21,540 were killed in homicides.

Toronto Police Service Report For The Year 2024 Included:

- Assault 21,400 (up 15%).
- Auto Theft − 3,102.
- Breaking and Entering − 5,030.
- Robbery 2,312 (up 21%).
- <u>Sexual Violations</u> **2,630** (up 17%).
- Theft Over \$5,000 979.
- Assault with a Weapon 4,489.
- Assault Causing Bodily Harm 1,001.
- Breaking and Entering with Intent 1,072.
- Robbery with a Weapon − 988.

Violent Crimes Against TTC Passengers In Toronto Is Also Increasing.


- In 2022, there was a reported increase of 46% in violent incidents against passengers compared to 2021.
- This represented <u>1,068 violent incidents</u>, which was <u>334 more than the previous year</u>, along with <u>assaults</u>, <u>robbery</u>, <u>theft</u>, <u>mischief</u>, and <u>harassment</u>.
- This included people being shoved onto the tracks, lit on fire, stabbed and swarmed.

In 2024, in a ranking of 60 large cities, Toronto was ranked as the <u>safest</u> major city in North America.

- The rate of police-reported community violence in Toronto increased by <u>14</u>% between 2014 and 2017.
- Between 2013 and 2017, the rate of firearm-related violent crime in Toronto more than doubled among youth.
- Among nine cities examined with populations over 500,000, Toronto had the third highest rate of firearm-related homicides.
- Again, in 2024, a ranking of 60 large cities, Toronto was ranked as the <u>safest</u> major city in North America.
